### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The City of Madison is aggressively pursuing transportation initiatives that increase roadway safety and promote sustainable transportation choices. This journey-level professional engineering position will support these efforts to create a more human centered transportation system. Activities associated with this position include identifying candidate projects, performing preliminary horizontal and vertical design, determining project feasibility, and estimating construction costs. Other work efforts could include preparing engineering studies, researching state of the practice, pursuing grant opportunities, and assisting in transportation improvements prioritization. Duties will include presenting projects and design concepts to committees and in public meetings; and interacting with other City and State agencies to move transportation projects forward.

The work is characterized by the exercise of technical and professional judgement. The work is performed under the general direction of the Director of Transportation, and includes extensive interaction with Transportation and Engineering staff.
